Staff will be extra vigilant where heaters are required in play areas. Access to outdoor play areas may be restricted to maintain indoor temperature.	C3
Reduced hygiene/spread of infection relating to messy/dirty play	Children/ Staff	B2	Anti-bacteria wipes will be made available to children for use after messy play. Staff will support use of wipes throughout the day to ensure children use wipes properly. Alcohol gels will be available in adult toilets.	B3
Spread of infection relating to toileting	Children/ Staff	B2	Anti-bacteria wipes will be made available to children for use after using the toilet. Staff will support use of wipes throughout the day to ensure children use wipes properly. Alcohol gels will be available in adult toilets.	B3
Risk of reaction to wipes used	Children	A2	All parents will be informed of the use of new wipes/alcohol gels on dropping off of their child to ascertain if allergies are present. Child friendly wipes will be used.	C3
Impact on hygiene of washing up	All people on site	C3	All washing up goes through heated dishwashers so this will not be affected.	C3
